

But this is not what defines Achala Joshi, who identifies herself as a philanthropist and a workaholic. With several awards in recognition of her works in education, social work, business and literature, this Gold medalist from Mumbai University is someone who prefers to stay away from the limelight. She is the recipient of Best Woman Entrepreneur of the year award from the President of India in 1993 and ventured into entrepreneurship at a time when even men dared not go into uncharted waters. She was the prime organizer of exhibitions and trade promotions by India in several International trade fairs. She was also a member of Planning Commission steering committee and has played her role in shaping trade policies of Maharashtra. She relentlessly works for the cause of upliftment of women and children, and firmly believes that there is no better social work than providing employment to people. Her book, Ashram Navache Ghar, has won her various national and international literary awards.
