
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Report on Project: Vachan Sankalp Maharashtra

Activity 01: Graffiti Board

03 & 04 /01/2025

The event witnessed active participation from students, teachers, and non-teaching staff. Activity 06: Library Visit

As a part of the Vachan Sankalp Maharashtracha celebrations, a visit to Mumbai Marathi Grantha Sangrahalaya was organized jointly by the Department of Marathi and Department of English on January 9, 2025. 77 students and two teachers visited 'Mumbai Marathi Grantha Sangrahalaya' a well-known library at Dadar, Mumbai. The library had organized a book exhibition displaying the works of renowned Marathi authors and poets. Students were shown the entire library, and they were also guided by library staff about the system of their functioning.

The librarian, Ms. Mitali Taral, interacted with students sharing the details of the library. Being one of the India's oldest libraries, founded in 1898, it has a collection of more than 645,569 books, some of which are rare and over 200 years old. This library is a treasure house of documents related to the history of Maharashtra and a reliable source of knowledge of various subjects. The library subscribes to numerous Marathi magazines and journals, preserving valuable articles, essays, and reports. During the visit, students also shared their thoughts on importance of books, habit of reading and about their visit to the library as well. Overall, it was an enriching and enlightening experience for the students.
