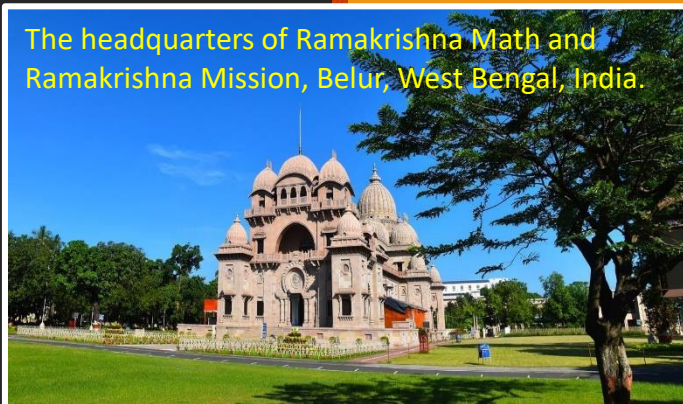
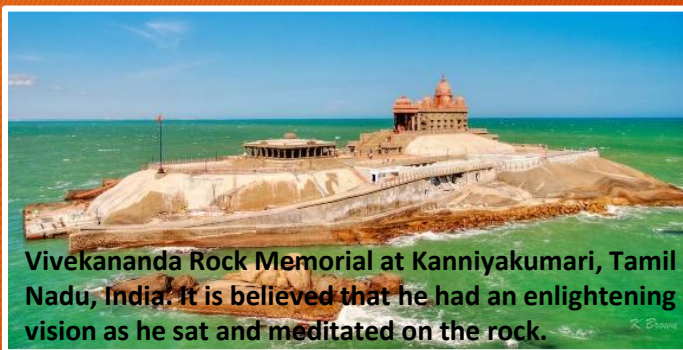
Always stressing the humanistic side of Vedanta philosophy, Vivekananda upheld the ideas of universal oneness, self-improvement, and absolute abstinence from dogma and superstition. He adapted and made relevant to the modern masses the very highest ideals of Vedanta and attempted to infuse vigor into Hindu thought and bring about a spiritual rejuvenation.

Swami Vivekanand established the Ramakrishna Mission, an organization dedicated to social service, education, spiritual development and philanthropy, and the Vedanta Societies in America and England. The organizations Vivekananda had set up during his lifetime have expanded over the years. Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission now have more than 200 centers globally and are present in more than 20 countries outside India.

He is seen as a key figure in modernizing Hinduism by interpreting its philosophy in a universal and modern way, emphasizing the divinity of the soul. His teachings and philosophy, particularly his call for self-realization and service to humanity, continue to inspire people worldwide. His birthday is celebrated as National Youth Day in India since 1985.
